Anti-social Behaviour

Recently, there has been a significant increase in levels of anti-social behavior experienced in and around the Greenfields area. For instance, a number of houses have been burgled, cars have been stolen, property vandalised, wheelie bins set on fire, and underage drinking is occurring in the green area at the end of the estate. Residents are encouraged to take preventive steps to reduce the likelihood of anti-social behaviour occurring:

- Ensure all windows and door are securely locked when your house is vacant
- Inform neighbours if you are leaving your house unattended for a long duration
- Leave lights on and use external lights to deter burglars
- Securely store wheelie bins in rear gardens
- Keep a watchful eye and report suspicious activity

The Greenfields Residents Association are committed to combating such problems but we need the help and assistance of all residents. Should you be witness to any sort of anti-social behaviour or suspicious activity please inform the **Gardai** on 051 305300. In addition, please report such incidents to **Brian Power** (Greenfields Neighbourhood Watch Area Coordinator - No.1 Beech Grove) on 087 9762955. Brian will provide you with assistance and will report any incidents to the Gardai, Community Policing and to the other members of the Greenfields Residents Association.



MapAlerter.com

Waterford City Council is now an official alerter on MapAlerter.com. This means that you can receive alerts directly from the Council as soon as they are issued through MapAlerter.com free of charge. Text Message, Email and Landline alerts are provided for the following categories:

- Water Service Alerts (SMS, Email and Landline alerts for Water Service Interruptions, Burst Mains or Boil Water Notification)
- Scheduled Major Road Works and Road Closures (SMS and Email will include affected areas and offer advice on diversions)
- Flood Alerts (If there is a risk of flooding for a specific area then you will receive SMS and Email alerts immediately)
- Major Road Accidents and Incidents (This includes SMS and Email Alerts for major road accidents which will cause serious traffic disruption)
- Bridge Lifts (Receive SMS and Email Alerts with the date and time of the next scheduled bridge lift on Rice Bridge)

Registration requires that you supply your mobile number and email address so that MapAlerter.com can deliver alerts to you. So sign up today at MapAlerter.com
